# Für eine Kultur der Menschenrechte

Donnerstag, 22. November 2018, 11:00 – 13:00 Uhr  
Berlin, Französische Friedrichstadtkirche

Vor 70 Jahren, am 12. Dezember 1948, formulierten die Vereinten Nationen mit der Allgemeinen Erklärung der Menschenrechte das Wertefundament für die Weltgemeinschaft. Dieses Jubiläum ist Anlass zum Feiern – aber auch Ansporn zum Handeln. Denn überall in der Welt, auch in Deutschland, stellen Teile der Gesellschaft die Menschenrechte in Frage, säen Hass gegen andere Menschen und bedrohen das friedliche Miteinander in unserer offenen und demokratischen Gesellschaft. Damit werden zunehmend auch die Freiheit der Kunst und der Medien in Zweifel gezogen. Gleichzeitig stellen sich viele Kulturschaffende populistischen Bewegungen entgegen und unterstützen Bündnisse im Sinne der Menschenrechte.

Welche Rolle spielen die Menschenrechte im und für den Kulturbereich? Wie können sie im Kulturbereich gestärkt werden? Wie können wiederum Kulturschaffende ihrerseits dazu beitragen, die Menschenrechte zu verwirklichen? Haben Kulturschaffende angesichts der aktuellen Herausforderungen eine besondere Verantwortung für den Einsatz für Menschenrechte? Über diese Fragen möchten wir ins Gespräch kommen.



# THE UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF Human Rights

Recognition of the inherent dignity and of the equal rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of freedom, justice and peace in the world,

whereas disregard and contempt for human rights have resulted in such atrocities that the conscience of humanity is shocked and in which human beings shall enjoy freedom of speech and belief and freedom from fear and want has been proclaimed as the highest aspiration of the common people,

whereas it is essential, if man is not to be compelled to have recourse, as a last resort, to rebellion against tyranny and oppression, that human rights should be proclaimed by the United Nations,

whereas the peoples of the United Nations have in the Charter reaffirmed their faith in the Charter of the United Nations and have decided to accept the principles contained therein as a common standard of achievement for all peoples and all nations, and to strive to realize these principles in co-operation with the United Nations and in accordance with the provisions of the Charter and the principles of the Charter,

whereas the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations on 10 December 1948, is the first time in the history of humanity that the rights and freedoms of every individual have been proclaimed as a common standard of achievement for all peoples and all nations,

whereas the recognition of the rights and freedoms of every individual is essential for the full realization of the rights and freedoms of the human race,
